

James Sanders Will

I James Sanders of the County of Moore and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and declare this my last will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say:

Item 1st That my Executors hereinafter named shall provide for my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my friends and relations and pay all funeral expenses together with my just debts, burials and to whomsoever owing out of the monies that may first come into his hands as a part or parcel of my estate

Item 2^o My will and desire that my wife have all my personal and real estate consisting of two negro girls and their heirs my turnip horse cows, sheep hog, poultry, house hold and kitchen furniture in fine every thing of which I am possessed after paying all my just debts which she is to have hold and use in any manner she thinks will be best for her and my children during her natural life

Item 3^o My will and desire that at the death of my wife that all of which she then may be possessed to be divided equally between our children for them to have and use forever

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my trusty friend my wife my lawful Executors to all intents and purposes to

Execute this my last will and Testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same and every part and clause thereof, hereby revoking and declaring utterly void all other wills and Testaments by me here before made In witness where of I the said James Sanders do hereunto set my hand and seal this the 24th of Aug^r 1864
