I Give the bed and furniture whereon I now lie to my

to my Daughter Sabra Gilbert and the bed with a white tick
and the furniture thereof to my Daughter Rebekah Myrick
and the remaining bed (being a small one) and its furniture
to my Daughter Sarah Stinson and my will is further
that each of the said beds and the furniture to the belong-
ing to be valued by indifferent persons Chosen by my
aforesaid Daughters for that purpose and that they who
have the best Beds pay as much to the others as will
make the Value equal to all my four Daughters a

 Shillings Sterling by her freely to be possessed and enjoyed
 Ninthly I likewise make and ordain the sole Executor of this
 my last will and testament and I do hereby wholly dis-
 -allow Revoke and disannul all and every other former tes-
 -taments Wills Legacies bequeaths Executors by me in any
 wise before named Willed and bequeathed Ratifying and
 confirming this and no other to be my last will and testa-
 -ment in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my last will
 hand and date this tenth day of May in the year of our Lord
 one thousand seven hundred and Ninety seven
