Isaac Peterson of the State of North Carolina and County of Moore do Make publick and declare the following to be my last will and testament I give bequest and devise unto John Fairley of Richmond County or his heirs one tract of Land in said County of Moore containing one hundred Acres on the Western of Durham Creek adjoining the Lands of Andrew and William one cow belonging one two year Old Stear one father Brand one pasture one pot and pot Tack and the whole of my property of Every kind and description. But intend that said trustee at the afore said property remain in possession of my son (Willm) Peterson and that he the said (Willm) have the use benefit profit and income of the same during his life and he hereby authorize request and empower my said trustee with the advice and consent of my said son (Willm) to sell any part or the whole of the above said property and make goods and sufficient bills to the same and the Money arising from said sale to be paid to my said son (Willm) for his own use and benefit - This hereby constitutes nominate and appoint my true and true friend Alexander Monk to this my last will and testament In Witness whereof I the said Isaac Peterson have hereunto set my hand and seal this 8th day of December A.D. 1826.

Isaac Check's will

In the Name of God Amen; Isaac Check of the County of Moore and State of North Carolina being of sound Mind and Memory and being informed of the certainty of death and the uncertainty of the time recommend my soul to God who gave it and my body to the grave whereon their resolution shall take place do Make Ordain and Establish this my last will and testament involving all former wills to what ever by me made - In the first place I bequeath and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary one hundred Acres of Land on Deep River to be laid off on the South East corner of my Land in the form of a Square or as nearly as may be convenient to include my dwelling House and out Houses which it is my will that my wife shall enjoy during her life or widowhood as aforesaid - Secondly; I give and bequeath to my wife My Negro Slaves, Aking, Peter, Henry, Lada, Sarah, and Mary during her life or widowhood - Thirdly; After the death or marriage of my wife I give and bequeath My Negro Girl Sarah and her increase to my daughter Polly - Fourthly; After the death or marriage of my wife I give and bequeath my Negro Girl Sarah and her increase to my daughter Polly - Fifthly; After the death or marriage of my wife I give and bequeath My Negro Girl Mary and her increase to my daughter Lucy Ann - Sixthly; My Land not before given and devised to my wife I give and devise to my sons in fee to be Equally divided between them all, and also that part of my Land I have given and devised in a preceding clause of this will to my wife I give and devise on or at the death or marriage of my wife to all my sons in fee to be Equally divided between them - Seventhly; As to my daughter Polly, Peter and Lucy Ann and as to my sons I bequeath my father's real and personal estate and also my land - Eighthly; To my son John I bequeath a young horse brown to the name of Charley - Ninthly; on the death or marriage of my wife I do bequeath and ~~devise~~ devise that My Negro Peter, Aking and Henry shall belong to my five youngest sons to wit to John William Blake Isaac Jacob and James to be Equally divided between them and if any or either of my said five youngest sons should be dead without leaving lawful issue at the death or marriage of my wife then the share to go

Joab Cheek Will

To the Survivors or Successor - Fourthly, as to the rest and residue of my stock of saddle horses and sheep and of my farming utensils and household and kitchen furniture I may be possessed of and not hereafter disposed of I will and direct to be sold by my Executors (then leaving however in the possession of my wife and for her use and comfort during her life or widowhood a sufficient quantity of said stock utensils and furniture to render her situation and that of her family comfortable - Eleventh; After selling so much of the stock utensils and furniture as is directed to be sold by the last preceding bequest of this will a sufficiency should not be raised to pay my Debts I will and direct that Peter shall be sold, or that person by my Executors Twelfth; In consideration of the large and liberal portion I have given and bequeathed to my wife, I request will bequeath and direct that my wife so long as she shall remain single and unmarried shall out of the proceeds of the property I have left her support and educate my children until they come of age or marry in the best manner her prudence and judgment shall direct and as she may be able to do - a duty which I have no doubt she will cheerfully perform - Thirteenth; As I have already done good part by my Douglass Willly Elliot I cannot in Justice to my other children give her any thing in addition to my former bounty kindly conforming to her what I have heretofore given her and which she has now possessed - Fourteenth; After the payment of my ~~last~~ debts out of the money arising from the sale of a portion of my stock utensils and furniture or before directed and arising from the sale of Peter (if he should be necessary) I should any surplus remain I will and bequeath that it be Equally divided among my nine youngest children - Fifteenthly, as to all the rest and residue of my Estate of every kind sort and description including all my rights credits and demands I now or hereafter to receive I leave will and bequeath

Joab Cheek Will

To my nine youngest children to be Equally divided ^{between} among them Lastly; I hereby nominate and appoint my Brother John Cheek and my friend Col. Richard Stuart and my son Thomas Cheek Executors of this my last will and testament working all towards by signing my hand and affixing my seal thereto; Witness written on two sheets of paper and intended before signed and dated some this second day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty (1820) ^{Witness} Elias Jones Joab Cheek Seal

Joab Cheek do hereby publish and declare the following to be a correct and true last will and testament - I hereby declare that part of my property which remains all my lands to be Equally divided among all my sons and of my son Thomas I have had to pay a considerable sum of money for him and hereby give and devise all my lands to my other five sons Equally to be divided to the devise made to my wife during her life or widowhood as set forth in my said will and hereby make the appointment of my son Thomas and Richard Stuart as two of my Executors and hereby nominate and appoint my Brother John Cheek and my son Joab Cheek the sole Executors of my last will and testament - and therein I have bequeathed to my three Daughters Polly, Mary and Lucy each three Negro Girls such as Sarah, Betty & their increase at my wife's death or, ^{some} three years of age as a slave more fully appear from my said will - Now if said Negroes, from having children should prove an expense it is my will that such expense shall be paid by my Daughters respectively to the same such Negroes are bequeathed - I also give I bequeath to my sons each, Brantley, & James each a horse which shall be valued at fifty Dollars and to each a saddle & bridle. Witness my hand and seal this fifteenth day of August 1820 - Moore County Court
