Carolina being weak in body but of sound and perfect memory and calling to mind the mortality of my body do hereby constitute and appoint this to be by my last will and testament in manner and form following First I recommend my soul to God that gave it and my body to be decently buried at the discretion of my executors or executor hereafter mentioned and nothing doubting of the resurrection at the last day And as to my worldly goods which it hath pleased God to bestow on me I give and bequeath in the following manner I give and bequeath to my eldest son William Eagle five Shillings Current money & no more I give to my son Christian Eagle fifty Acres of Land joining the land he now has on and no more I give and bequeath to my son Henry Eagle five Shillings & no more I give and bequeath to my son Peter Eagle three Shillings & no more I give and bequeath to my son John Eagle two hundred Acres of Land joining Cornsicks Lathers Land Except what Mr John McCutley has taken of Also twenty two & half Acres of Land joining the said two hundred Acres also one horse that he has now & the two Cows & calves & a two year old Bull which he now has and no more I give and bequeath to my son Jacob Eagle one hundred acres of Land & fifty Acres of Land which I bought of John McCutley lying on the meadow branch of Wolf Creek Also the horse he now has & one Cow and calf and no more I give and bequeath to my son George Eagle one hundred Acres of Land joining Peter Eagles Land & whereon human lives I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Catherine Eagle two hundred & twenty Acres of Land containing the plantation whereon I now live joining the lands of William, Christian & Henry Eagle whereon they now live & also joining the land I give my son Eagle during his natural life and at the death thereof to go to my last son Martin Eagle & it is my will that

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if my wife lives till the said Martin is twenty one years of age and it should be his desire to settle himself on the said Land that he may settle on any part but not to disturb his mother from the said Land and bequeath to my son George Eagle one horse and one Cow calf I give and bequeath to my Daughter Susan Catherine backman five Shillings and no more I give and bequeath to my Daughter Eliza Hubbard five Shillings Current money and no more I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Human five Shillings and no more and it is my will that my wife to have all my household Furniture during her widowhood but in case she marries the furniture to be equally divided among her and my children and I hereby appoint my wife Catherine Eagle and my son William Eagle to be my executor & Executors of this my last will and testament and do hereby revoke all others & to wit my wife of I have been to set my hand and seal this 22^d day of March
