I Commit my Soul to Almighty God we give it,
and my body to the grave until the day of the
resurrection, and after all my Just debts is paid and
my funeral Expence. I give and bequeath unto my
faithful and beloved Wife Katharin all my household
furniture and farming Utensils during her Natural
life, and all my Land Containing Three Hundred acre
I give unto my Son Daniel Cameron after my Wife Kathar-
ins death one fourth, I give unto my Son John Cameron one
eighth, I give unto my Daughter Christiana Cameron
one fourth and half, - I give unto my Daughter Margaret
Cameron one fourth and half, - I give unto my Daughter Mary
Cameron one fourth and half, - I give the residue unto my Wife
Katharin the remainder of my Stock of all kind add my real
estate and the said property to be disposed of at my Wifes pleasure
after my death - I give the Foundation of this my last Will and
