The residue of my estate after taking out the dues and legacies above mentioned shall be Saldo, and the debts owing to me collected and if afterwards it be found insufficient to pay all my just debts my Will and Desire is that my Executer shall be pleasure to sell enough of the lands taken by me to him said wife his/her to pay said deficiency and if there shall be any surplus over and above the payment of debt and expenses that such surplus be paid over to my said wife Mary to her absolutely forever After and lastly I do hereby constitute & appoint my Trusty friend John Morrison my lawful Executer shall intitute my property herein this my last will and Testament according to the intent and meaning of the same and every part & clause thereof.
