 executor I confirm this and as other to be my last will &
 testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
 seal this twenty fourth Day of November 1799

In the name of God Amen Whereas I John Morgan of the County
 of Moore and State of North Carolina Being Sick and weak in
 Body but of perfect Sense and Memory do make this my last
 will and testament first I recommend my soul to God that
 gave it & my body to be buried in a ~~good~~ Christian like man-
 ner and as for my worldly goods to be distributed as followeth
 I give and bequeath to my wife beloved Son Joseph Morgan two hun-
 dred acres of Land lying joining Nathan Morgan's line the
 greatest part of it on the North Side of Cabin Creek & the
 young bay horse that is called his & a Sattel pally with a bridle
 in her face & one feather bed & furniture that is called his & a Sattel
 & bridle Likewise I give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter
 Angelina Morgan fifty Acres of Land lying on each side of Cab-
 in Creek joining Joseph Morgan's line & to my beloved daughter Mary
 Morgan I give & bequeath fifty Acres of Land lying on each side
 of Cabin Creek joining Joseph & Angelina's line & a Sattel Mare
 named Bage & one Mans Saddle one Feather bed & furniture
 And to my son James Morgan I give & bequeath two hundred
 Acres of Land with the manner plantation theron And my
 Riding Horse him & the Sattel pally that I bought of Angelina
 & my Riding Saddle & the Feather bed & furniture Call his &
 my Rifle Gun & Shot Pouch & unto my beloved Son William
 Morgan I give and bequeath ten Shillings & unto my
 Daughter Levisa Allen I give & bequeath ten Shillings like-
 wise To my beloved Son Nathan Morgan I give and bequeath
 Ten Shillings & to my beloved Daughter Eliza Dunn I give
 & bequeath ten Shillings & to my beloved Daughter Delley Smith
 I give and bequeath ten Shillings And unto my beloved son
 George Morgan I give and bequeath Ten Shillings & one hundred
 Acres of Land Call the Sprucey place & the one bay
 mare I desire to be sold & be divided among all my Children
 & now the Remainder part of my living not to be sold
 but to be equally divided between Joseph Morgan My
 Son & Angelina Morgan My Daughter & Mary Morgan
 my Daughter & James Morgan my son which now I
 will mention all the Cattle & Hogs Belonging to
 me
