

John Williamson's Will

In the name of God Amen I John Williamson of the County of Moore & State of N Carolina Being in perfect mind and memory thank to God for the same calling to mind mortality of the body and knowing that it is appointed for all to die do make and ordain this my last will and Testament that is at my decease I request to be buried in a Christian like and decent manner at the direction of my Executors and as touching my worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give devise and dispose of the same in manner and form following that is to say In the first place I give to my son William Williamson all my landed property Namely ^{part} of in the County of Moore Except the back of Land that I give to my Daughter Nancy Manus described by bounds in a former deed I also give to my Daughter ~~Mary~~ Nancy Manus a back of Land she & her husband Daniel Manus lives on the same is described by bounds in a deed said Land I give to my said Daughter Nancy and her heirs only & to them for ever also I give to my Daughter Elizabeth one whole shear and one third of all my moveable property I also give the balance of all my moveable property to be Equally divided between my Son William Williamson John Williamson Briggett Care Sarah Shuffe Dinny Mullen Nancy Manus to be divided after my decease I likewise constitute make and ordain Nicholas Hall & Joseph Care my only and sole Executors of this my last will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifth day of May 1789 Signed sealed published pronounced & declared by me John Williamson sen for my last will

Rich Campbells Will

In the Name of God Amen I Rich Campbell of the County of Moore and State of North Carolina being of sound and perfect mind and Memory thank to God do this Thirtieth day of June 1783 make and publish this my last will and Testament in Manner following that is to say —
 First, I gave and bequeath to my beloved wife Katherine the third of this plantation where we now live during her natural life to gether with all the Cattle and Land & plantation that is of her kind and what she should in kind of the house and furniture that is to say for ever and no more —
 Secondly I gave and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah that she should have in her own she was married and she had a son she got at the same time to gether with ten dollars out of my Estate now to get her another dow —
 Thirdly I gave to my son when the three hundred dollars that he got when married also one Moor two cows and a heather head at the same time when he was married together with that plantation on where he now lives —
 Fourthly I gave and bequeath to my Daughter Mary that she should have when married, also another Moor one cow and a heather —
 Fifthly I gave and bequeath to my son Samuel the two thirds of this plantation and the other part his allowed to my wife as above mentioned as long as she lives and when she dies her part of the Land as above mentioned shall be divided between Samuel my son to gether with every thing else that will be on the plantation after my wife's death only this I am bound my son and his Mother are to pay all debts due on the plantation during their life time or until the due comes to pay it Signed sealed published and declared by the said Rich Campbell the testator as in last Will and Testament in the presence of Rich Williams Nicholas Hall
