 Heirs Executors and assigns to warrant and defend the said Negro Slaves unto
 the said Daniel Paterson his Heirs Executors against all persons whatsoever
 claiming the same I swear that if I Joshua Harris do and shall within three
 months from the day of this Bill being sold & delivered, & Bill of Sale taken unto the
 said Daniel Paterson for one Negro woman slave that is sound & likely above the
 age of thirteen years under the age of sixteen years and that he the said Harris
 shall run the risk of the aforesaid Negroes the 6th Month then this Bill of Sale to be
 void & null otherwise to remain in full force & virtue In witness whereof the
 said Joshua Harris have hereunto set my hand and seal the Twentieth day
 of October Anno Domini 1790

 Heirs & assigns the property of the said Negroes from all persons whatsoever lawfully
 claiming the same I swear that if I Philip Robson do and shall within three
 months from the day of this Bill being sold & delivered, & Bill of Sale taken unto the
 said James Robson for one Negro woman slave that is sound & likely above the
 age of thirteen years under the age of sixteen years and that he the said Robson
 shall run the risk of the aforesaid Negroes the 6th Month then this Bill of Sale to be
 void & null otherwise to remain in full force & virtue In witness whereof the
 said Philip Robson have hereunto set my hand and seal the Twentieth day
 of October Anno Domini 1790
