Heirs Executors and Assigns to warrant and Defend the said Negro slaves unto
the said Daniel Paterson his Heirs Executors against all persons whatever
I declare moreover that I Joshua Harris do and shall within three
Months from the day of the Date hereof sell & Deliver, & Bill of Sale make unto the
said Daniel Paterson for One Negro woman slave that is sound & likely above the
Age of Thirteen Years & under the Age of Sixteen Years and that he the said Harris
shall bear the Risk of the aforesaid Negro the 3rd Month after this Bill of Sale to be
void & null otherwise to remain in full force & Virtue In witness whereof the
said Joshua Harris have hereunto set my hand and seal the Twenty Third Day
Of October Anno Domini 1790

Know all men by these presents that I Philip Abston of Moore County and State of North Carolina for and in consideration of Two Hundred & Ninety Pounds in money paid have Bargined Sold and Delivered & by these presents do Bargain Sell and Deliver unto James Abston Three Negroes (viz) Tinker a Fellow of about Twenty Three years of age Esopus a boy about Eighteen years of age and Ben about Nine years of age And the said Philip Abston for myself my Heirs Executors & Administrators do warrant and defend unto the said James Abston his Heirs & Appurtenances the property of the said Negroes from all persons whatsoever lawfully claiming the same I witness whereof I have written set my hand and seal this 23^d day of July 1779 and in the 1111 Year of our Independence Philip Abston
