Sc. of the County of Hesse and State of North
Carolina Being of sound mind and memory and
desiring to mend the mortality of my Body do make
Publick and Declare the following Disposition
of my real estate personal Estate to be my Last
will and Testament.

Item the first I give and devise unto my beloved wife Catharine
Murchison during her natural life two hundred and
fifty acres of Land including my Dwelling House
and the plantation on which I now reside I also
give unto my beloved wife Catharine during her
natural life or widowhood one Bay mare my herd
more my road wagon all the Balance of my cattle
and Sheep after taking therefrom two cows and
calves and twelve head of Sheep to be given to

together also my Stock of Hogs all my House hold
and Kitchen furniture and all my farming utensils.
I further request and desire my executors hereafter
named to permit my aged man Jeffre to remain
with her while she lives unmarried for the support
of herself and children.

2. I give and bequeath unto my son Duncan Murchison
30 Silver Cap.

3. I give and bequeath unto Peggy Sinclair wife of Peter
Sinclair one Dollar, also to John Murchison one
Dollar, also to William Murchison one Dollar, also
to Nancy Murchison wife of John Murchison one
Dollar, also to Colin Murchison one Dollar, also to
Polly Lyon wife of Will Lyon one Dollar, and
also to Remmuth B. Murchison one Dollar, they being
all of my children which are living which were
Born of my first wife Catharine (that is today
Deacon)

4. I also give and bequeath unto the heirs of
Isabella England deceased wife of William
T. England one Dollar, and to the heirs of
Sarah Worthy deceased wife of James Worthy
one Dollar.

5. I also give and bequeath unto Catharine Currie
wife of Daniel Currie as heretofore named
one cow and calf and six head of Sheep

6. I also give and bequeath unto Flora M. London
one cow and calf and six head of Sheep

7. I also give good and devise unto my son Alexander
Murchison one tract of Land lying on the little
Rocky Creek on which the said Alexander now resides
containing two hundred acres I also give and bequeath
unto the said Alexander forty Dollars it being
the Balance now in the hands of the said Alexander
which was due me in consequence of the sale

 Murchison one negro girl abmed Katty by her paying
 my Daughter Christian twenty five Dollars as soon
 as she arrives at Eighteen years of age or three shillings
 10. I also give and bequeath unto my Daughter Lydia
 one negro girl named Hannah by her paying my
 Daughter Christian as before named twenty five
 Dollars payable as soon as the said Christian arrives
 at the age of eighteen.
 11. I also give and bequeath unto my Daughter Linda one
 negro girl named Mary by her paying my Daughter
 Christian twenty five Dollars payable as soon as
 the said Christian arrives at the age of eighteen
 years
 Item the 1st I also give unto my Daughter Christian twenty five
 Dollars which I will and intend to paid as
 follows that is twenty five Dollars to be paid her
 by my Daughter Rebecca, twenty five Dollars to
 be paid her by Lydia my Daughter, and twenty five
 Dollars to be paid her by my Daughter Linda in
 Order to equalise the said Christians portion of my
 Estate with each of them, I also give grant and
 Devise to my said Daughter Christian one tract of
 Land inclosing Duncan Murchison Esq. and Duncan
 Murchison Esq. containing forty acres
 12. I also give grant and Devise unto my son
 Aaron one tract of Land inclosing Gilbert Mc
 Rae and the Lands bequeathed to my son Alexander
 in several tracts containing eight hundred acres with

some more or less subject to the life estate as before
 named of my beloved wife in two hundred and
 fifty acres as before stated the said two hundred and
 fifty acres I also give and devise to the said Aaron
 at his mother death which is included in the
 Eight hundred acres above specified I also give and
 bequeath unto my son Aaron my grey Horse one negro
 woman by the name of Fanny.

14. It is further my will and desire that at the death or
 marriage of my beloved wife Catherine that negro
 Jerry should be then living and all the personal
 property left her during her natural life or widowhood
 which then may be on hand that the same be sold
 by my executors hereafter to be named and the
 proceeds of the said sale to be equally divided
 among my children by my last wife.

15. It is also my will that my executors hereafter named
 sell my part of my cattle or stock on such credit
 as they may think proper as will be sufficient to pay
 the legacies bequeathed to my children by my first
 wife my funeral expenses and my debt which I
 may be owing, the balance of my personal property
 then remaining is what I design for my beloved
 wife that is accepting the two cows and calves
 and the two head of sheep before bequeathed
 I nominate and appoint my beloved sons Duncan
 and Aaron Murchison my executors to carry this
 my last will and Testament into effect ratifying
 and confirming this my last will and Testament
 in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and seal this the 18th day of June in the year of
 our Lord 1834

In the name of God amen. I Archibald McDugald
of the County of Moore and State of North Carolina,
Being of sound and perfect mind and memory (Blessed be god) Do this seventh day of June in the
year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and
thirty one, make and publish this my last will
and Testament, in manner following, That is to say,
my desire is to be buried after the manner of the Christian
Burial and decency and that all my debts and Funeral
expenses be paid as soon after my deceas as may be convenient
from the monies which is now at hand -

First, I give and bequeath to my loving wife the one
third of the Land lying south of the Hay-mill road
including the House where I live and all other buildings
attached thereto and also one third part of about
an acre and during her natural life and after
her deceas to return to my son Dugald M^c Dugald,
also I give and bequeath to her the house built for her,

and after her deceas to return to my son Dugald M^c Dugald
also I give and bequeath unto her the old mare and her
foal, also three beds and furniture and such a part
of my other household and Kitchin Furniture as she
may desire not in future particulary specified -
Secondly, I give and bequeath to my son Daniel M^c
Dugald the negroes Ned and George and one half
of three hundred and fifty nine acres of Land it
being the upper part of my Land on the Dry fork
branch, also one mare called fly one bed and Furniture
one Folding Table, also the one third part of all the tools
and Farming utensils also the tenth part of the cattle
Sheep &c

Thirdly, I give and bequeath to my son Dugald M^c Dugald
two thirds of my Land it being the lower part and after
his mothers Death my will is that his third part for life
return to my son Dugald M^c Dugald also I give and
Bequeath to him the negroes Frank, George, Aaron,
Simon, Rose, Catherine, and Hannah also one goat
shear (four years old) and a Stud (two year old), two
beds, and furniture one Secretary and a Folding-table
the sixth part of the cattle and Sheep, one third part
of the tools and Farming utensils also a cotton
works in six Volumes and Silver watch -

Fourthly, I give and bequeath to my son Alexander M^c
Dugald the one half of three hundred and fifty nine
acres of Land it being the upper part of the Land
on the Dry fork also I give and bequeath to him
the negroes Peter, Jack, and Anny, one bed and
furniture one third part of Tools and Farming utensils
the sixth part part of the stock of cattle Sheep or
also one Bay year old Filly -

Dugald the negroes Tom, Anthony, and Dina one
bed and furniture the sixth part of the cattle Sheep or
also Davids Bournals in two Volumes -
