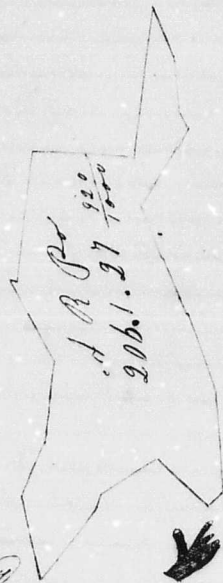

State of North Carolina } In the name of God amen
Meem County } I Louchlin Curry of the county
and State aforesaid though weak in body and
destitute of health yet of perfect mind and
memory blessed be God for his mercies do make this
my last will and Testament in manner and form
as follows that is to say in the first place
I give and bequeath unto my dear and loving wife
Sarah Curry my plantation on which I now live
containing 335 acres with all every the appurtenances
thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining
during natural life to me of the S^r Sarah Curry
my wife and that the children shall have the privilege
of cultivating the plantation and whatever will be wanted
on the place for and about what will be needed to
support the family and to get at the necessary
shall go to the use of the children -
I give and bequeath unto my dear and loving son
Curry one hundred acres of land on Little River joining
Mr. Hollams and John Polles lands -
I also request that both my sons to wit David and
Duncan Curry to have my wagon that is now in
making for one between them and for them two to pay
the blackman for 10th season -
also all my household and kitchen furniture and
all my farming utensils to be for the use of my wife
and family as long as she lives -
I also give unto each of my children one cow a piece
out of my stock of cattle I request that my grandsons
Beck and that my wife Sarah Curry have the way
over my coast -
all my stock of Hogs to be sold for the use of the family
It is also my will that after the death of my wife
Sarah Curry that all my children sons and daughters
have an equal share of all the land and all other
property that may be in the possession of my wife at

with the wife annexed

In which I also request that my youngest son Lauchlin Curry get fifty Dollars in money and the crop that is now on hand in testimony whereof I the Sr. Lauchlin Curry have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 31st July in the year of our Lord 1833

I Rimnith Murchison Sr. of the County of Moore and State of North Carolina Being of sound mind and memory and calling to mind the mortality of my body do make Publick and Declare the following Disposition of my real ~~estate~~ personal Estate to be my Last Will and Testament -

Now the first I give and devise unto my beloved wife Catharine Murchison during her natural life two hundred and fifty acres of Land including my Dwelling House and the plantation on which I now reside I also give unto my beloved wife Catharine during her natural life or widowhood one Bay mare my saddle and my road waggon, all the Balance of my cattle and Sheep after taking therefrom two cows and calves and twelve head of Sheep to be given to

Catharine Curry and Flora M. London as will appear hereafter also my stock of Hogs all my House hold and Kitchen furniture and all my farming utensils. I further request and desire my Executors hereafter named to permit my negro man Jesse to remain with her while she lives unmarried for the support of herself and children -

- 2^d I give and bequeath unto my son Duncan Murchison 30 Silver cups -
- 3^d I give and bequeath unto Peggy Sinclair wife of Peter Sinclair one Dollar, also to John Murchison one Dollar, also to William Murchison one Dollar, also to Nancy Murchison wife of John Murchison one Dollar, also to John Murchison one Dollar, also to Polly Tyson wife of Will Tyson one Dollar, and also to Rimnith B. Murchison one Dollar, they being all of my children which are living which were Born of my first wife Catharine (that is including Duncan)
- 4th I also give and bequeath unto the Heirs of Isabella England deceased wife of William England one Dollar, and to the Heirs of Jennet Wooty deceased wife of James Wooty one Dollar -
- 5th I also give and bequeath unto Catharine Curry wife of Daniel Curry as herebefore named one cow and calf and six head of Sheep
- 6th I also give and bequeath unto Flora M. London one cow and calf and six head of Sheep
- 7th I also give grant and devise unto my son Alexander Murchison one tract of Land lying on the Little Portel Creek in which the said Alexander now lives containing two hundred acres I also give and bequeath unto the said Alexander forty Dollars it being the Balance now in the hands of the said Alexander which was due me in consequence of the sale
