

Locky Morris' Will

I Locky Morris of the County of Moore and State of North Carolina, being of Sound and disposing Mind and Memory do make, publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and following

Item 1st I will devise and bequeath to my beloved wife Margaret Morris, after paying all my just debts out of my estate, every article of personal property that I now own or may own at my death consisting of Hens, hoes and Kitchen furniture, Stock &c of different kind all my personal estate of every kind and description to her and her heirs forever.

Item 2nd I will devise and bequeath to my said beloved wife Margaret during her life the tract of Land whereon I now reside containing fifty acres.

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint A. H. McNeill my Executor to execute this my last Will and Testament and carry back and claim thereof.

In Witness whereof I have signed my hand and seal this 10th July 1864
