Item. I give and bequeath to my Son Archibald a certain Negro boy called Tom which was given him soon after his Marriage - also about £
~~Land~~ Three Hundred Pounds of Land on which there shall
still now be a House, to the above bequeath & in another
Article will be incorporated which is desired accompanying
to Necessities. Item. My will and desire is that the Negroes
belong to my Wife Sarah during the Natural life shall be
Equally divided between my Sons Archibald & William
Alexander David and Ann wife of Samuel Wills
Item. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Anna a piece of
Land in Deep River called her Barn field -

Item. My will and desire is that my Executor here in
after named shall at his discretion sell as much of
my Estate as shall be sufficient to pay all my just Debts
and that the rest of Cattle Hogs and Sheep remain on the
premises whereon my Wife lies at her death to be and
belong to my Sons Daniel -

Item. I do hereby appoint my Son Daniel W. Niles Executor
to this my Last Will and Testament.

Malcom T. W. Niles of the State of North Carolina and
County of More being of sound and perfect Mind and
Memory do make this my last Will and Testament I bequeath
my Soul to God and my Body to the Earth. I will and bequeath
to my brother John & Dick Niles my land on the South Side
of the Great fence that is near the Barn in the same direction
with said Great fence as far as my Lands extend that covers
also my dwelling by parcel the said John & Dick Niles is to
pay to my wife Margaret Smith twenty five Dollars out of said
Land - I will and bequeath to my nephews Thomas. & H. C. My
Lands on the North Side of the above mentioned Great fence
With the said direction as far as my land extends that covers
including my Houses. the said Thomas is to pay to my
wife Margaret Smith twenty five Dollars out of said
Land - I will and bequeath to my Sister Mary Elizabeth
Sarah June & Niles my Negro girl pay the said Mary
E. S. Niles to pay twenty five Dollars to my wife
Margaret Smith also twenty five Dollars to my wife
Mary Ann Smith out of said Negro provided the said
Negro pay does not die in twelve months from this date
and if said Negro dies in that time these last mentioned
payments is not to be made. I also will and bequeath
to my Sister Mary E. S. Niles my Tools and Clothing
intended to be sold at publick or private sale my Stock
of Horses cattle and Hogs also my Kitchen furniture
panning utensils and Many other thing besides to
mention. I my power my Executor to collect with the
Many and mostly Holes and defaults my Just debts to
pay and to ensure Money enough to get three sets
of lumber Stones one set for my Father one for my
Sister Anna and one set for my self and the better
to be divided Equally among the children mentioned
and bequeath to be divided by my sister Mary
