Willed to my Wife Sarah during her Natural Life shall be Equally divided between My Sons Archibald William Alexander Daniel and John heirs of Daniel M. Mills

I Now Give and bequeath to my Daughter Ann a piece of Land on Deep River called the Barn field -

I Now My Will and desire is that my Executor here in after named shall at his discretion sell as much of my Estate as shall be sufficient to pay all my Just Debts and that the Stock of cattle Horses and Sheep remains on the premises whereon my Wife lives at her death to be and belong to my Son Daniel -

I Now I do hereby Appoint my Son Daniel M. Mills Executor to this my last Will and Testament.

including my House the said Thomas M. M. is to pay to my Wife Margaret Smith twenty five Dollars out of said Land - I Give and bequeath to my Sister Mary Elizabeth

Smith two M. Mills my Negro girl pay the said Mary E. S. M. Mills to pay twenty five Dollars to my Wife Margaret Smith also twenty five Dollars to my Wife Mary Ann Smith out of said Negro provided the said

Negro pay does not die in twelve months from this date and if said Negro dies in that time these last mentioned payments is not to be made. I Give and bequeath to my Sister Mary E. S. M. Mills my Pans and Potting

Edward to be sold at publick or private Sale my Stock of Horses Cattle and Hogs also my Kitchen furniture

passing utensils and many other thing I desire to mention - I Give power my Executor to collect all the Money due and by Notes or Accounts my Just debts to pay and to receive Money enough to get these Sides

of Sides I Give one Sd. for my Father one for my Sister Ann and one Sd. for my Wife and the balance to be divided Equally among the with in mentioned
