In the name of God Amen I Malcolm Patterson of the
State of North Carolina Moore County planter being very
sick and weak but in perfect mind and memory thank be to
God for it calling into mind the mortality of my body and
knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make
and ordain this my last will and testament that is to say -
principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul
into the hand of almighty God that gave it and my body
I recommend it to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian burial
at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the
General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the right
of power of God And as touching such worldly Estate whic
with it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give and
dispose of the same in the following manner and
form First to all Creditors their lawful debts -
Then I give and bequeath to my dear beloved wife Sarah -
Patterson and the rest of my personal Property Equally divi
among them as they come to age except the negro Wm. who
is to be left to my wife her lifetime and afterwards to be
Equally divided among the Children and my real
Estate

Estate to be divided as follows Item to my dear beloved
son John Patterson I Give and bequeath three hundred Acres
of Land lying on dry Creek in aforesaid County Item to
my dearly beloved son William Patterson I Give and bequeath
one hundred & fifty Acres of Land lying on Cranes Creek in same
County Item to Malcom Patterson my dear beloved son I Give
and bequeath one hundred Acres of Land in Cumberland Coun
ty Dry Creek & Fifty on the aforesaid Road Moore County
where I now live and as fifty acres in Deep Creek fork And
I do hereby appoint my beloved wife Sarah Patterson Luan
Patterson as Executrix to sell and dispose of the property to the
best advantage until the children comes of age I likewise
constitute make and ordain the sole Executrix of this my late
will and testament all and singular by them freely disposed
and enjoyed and enjoyed as before mentioned And I do hereby fully
disallow revoke & disannull all every other former Wills testaments
legacies bequests and Executors by me before named willed and be
queathed ratifying and confirming this and no other to be last
will and testament In witness whereof I do have hereunto set
my hand and seal this Eighth Day of June in the year of our
Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety five

declared by the said Malcolm Patterson
as his last will and testament
