A Bill of Sale from Thomas Wade Sheriff to Thomas Maws
 State of North Carolina
 Anson County Feb 5 I now all men by these presents that
 I Thomas Wade Sheriff of Anson County Aforesaid by virtue
 of a Writ of Forefeiture to me directed wherein John Garner is
 Plaintiff against James Maws Esq. defendant in a suit
 brought in the County of Moore have for and in Considera-
 tion of the sum of fifty pounds Lawfull money to me in
 hand paid the sum aforesaid I do hereby acknowledge
 Have in Consequence of the aforesaid Writ Bargained
 and Sold to Thomas Maws one Negro boy named Ben aged
 about six years for the aforesaid Consideration of Fifty Pounds
 Being the highest bid made for the said Negro at Publick
 Vendue on the 14th Octobr 1786
 And by these presents I do make over Convey & Confirm
 unto the Said Thomas Maws his heirs and Assigns a good
 and sufficient Title unto the Said Negro boy Ben
 To have and to hold the sd Negro unto him the sd Thomas Maws
 His Heirs and Assigns forever and I do hereby warrant the
 Title of the Said Negro as Sheriff of the County aforesaid
 unto the Said Thomas Maws his heirs and Assigns against
 all Claims whatever I do witness whereof I have hereunto
 Set my hand and Seal this 14th Octo 1786

Indenture Martha Cotes to Simon Hart & wife
 This Indenture made this 20th day of November in the year of
 our Lord one thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty Six between
 Martha Cotes of Moore County of the one part and Simon Hart
 and Margaret Hart his wife of the aforesaid County and State of
 North Carolina of the other part witnesseth that the aforesaid
 Martha Cotes holds bounds and by these presents doth bind James
 oriah Cotes daughter of Martha Cotes Aged ten years the 20th day of
 August last Simon Hart and Margaret his wife the aforesaid
 James oriah Cotes to serve the aforesaid Simon Hart and Margaret
 his wife from the age of their majority until the said
 James oriah Cotes shall arrive to the age of eighteen years to serve and
 obey the aforesaid Simon Hart and Margaret his wife in all their
 lawfull commands not departing hereby from her said Master and
 Mistress & service during his time of service aforesaid but to behave
 and demean himself as a faithful servant to the aforesaid Simon
 Hart and Margaret his wife both master and master to and with
 Martha Cotes aforesaid to give the said James oriah Cotes one year
 schooling or to teach her to read and allows that drink lodging and
 Roasting and at the expiration of his service to allow her freedom
 dues according to custom of the State of North Carolina witnesseth
 that the parties above named have executed at their hands and affix
 this Indenture the day and date first above written

of the aforesaid James & Willis in every respects the aforesaid my business
and have this 8th day of February Anno Dom 1787 —

leaving Notes of hand bearing the date hereof given by me unto the said
