

MARTIN Mac PHERSONS Will

In the Name of god Amen I Martin W Pherson doon since
being weak in Body but of perfect Mind and Memory
Calling to Recollection the Mortality of my Body do publish
and Ordain the following disposition of my Real and personal
property as my last will and testament. Item first. I will
and desire that my beloved wife Christian Mac Pherson
Shall have the use and control of the plantation wherein
I now live to be Managed by her without Control, provided
during her Natural life together with all my Stock and
Household furniture with all the tools and Utencils belonging
to the plantation. Also will and bequeath that she shall have
and enjoy the use and possession of my Negro Girl Ritter
during her Natural life. Item second. I will and bequeath
to my Sons Martin W Pherson and Hugh W Pherson all
My landed property of every description and Desirability for which
I have any right in fee simple Reserving the use of the place
where I now live as above mentioned to my wife during her
Natural life and after her death the whole to be Equally divided
between Martin and Hugh Shaw and Shaw alike.

Item third. I will and desire that my Executors herein after to be
named shall execute in January 1822 Sell at publick Sale
at the discretion of the Executors my Negro Man Gregory and my
Negro Woman Judy and that the Money arising from that sale
when collected to equally divide between all my Children except
John W Pherson and Christian W Donald.

Item 4th. I will and desire that the cattle and Horse which
I have left to my son John and now in his possession to be
given to his children turning the same to their Father
during his Natural life. Item 5th. I will and desire that all
the Stock and furniture together with the Negro Girl Ritter &
Increase which I have above given my wife during her
Natural life shall at her death be sold at publick sale
by my Executors and that all the proceeds of that sale
shall be Equally divided Among all my Children Except
my Son John and my Daughter Christian Shaw and
Siamese Alice. Item 6th. I will and desire that some few

of my Son Hugh's Estate Shall be given to Martin W. Pherson as
payment of a debt which I owe him. My Son Martin of the Cross
to receipt the same in payment. Nominate and Appoint my son

will and testament to carry the same into Effect, and further by
invoke all other and former wills or testaments by me made Testifying
and Confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament

the 12th day of January 1821
