In the name of God amen I Nancy Thomas
being in sound mind and memory but knowing the
uncertainty of life and that it was appointed to all
men to die and after this to Judgement - do make
and ordain this to be my last will and testament
in manner as follows To wit

First I recommend my soul to God who give it
and that my body be decently buried -

2^d Item. I give and bequeath unto my beloved
children (namely) that is to say - Henderson
Thomas - Deas Thomas - Joseph Thomas - Gaty
Thomas and Patsy Thomas all my undivided
interest in the negro belonging to my hus-
band Frederick Thomas Sen^r also all my stock
of horses cattle hogs and sheep of every kind on
my negro gear on cart all my house hold and
kitchen furniture of every kind all my plantation
tools also set of blacksmiths tools and my property
of every description and that the above named
property be equally divided among the above named
children after my death -

3^d Item - Give and bequeath unto my beloved son Aaron
Thomas fifty Cuts in money -

4th Item - I give unto my beloved daughter Mary Linam fifty
Cuts in money -

Lastly I do hereby make and ordain my worthy friend and son
Deas Thomas my heir and executor to this my last
will and testament in Witness whereof the said Nancy
Thomas hereunto set my hand and seal this the
10th day of September 1838 -

of land and two cows and one mare -

three Dollars - Also I give unto my son Angus
Martin the sum of three Dollars - and also I give
unto my son-in-law - Thomas Hammon Jr. the sum of
three Dollars - I also ordain that all my stock
of Hogs household furniture and farming utensils
