I will and bequeath the sum of five dollars to Mimmy (a Slave) who has so faithfully attended on me during my sickness the said Slave being the property of Jesse Smithman

I also will and bequeath ten dollars to Jany the wife of Jim Revels

I further will and bequeath all the residue of my Estate after paying all heretofore named to my mutual friends Alexander L. Curry and Joseph L. Reid to be divided by them in the proportion of one third of the said residue to the said Alexander L. Curry and the other two thirds to the said Joseph L. Reid

I appoint Malcom M. Blue and Charles C. Shaw Executors to this my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have this the 20th day of Nov. A.D. 1838 set my hand and seal

The last will and Testament of Mary Brown of Moore County North Carolina.

I give and bequeath forever to my friend Francis W. Edwards of 1st county State my negro Man Mumbo also all my lands in 1st county on the Lurien creek being one hundred and eighty five acres more or less, one young sorrel mare, three years old next March, one cow & 4 pigs, four year old Hogs, one cat, seventy five bushels of Corn, one Thousand lbs Lard, and three hundred lbs Pork, one pot, one oven and one iron and one Kettle also all farming tools I give and bequeath to my nephew John Henry Grier Perry one sorrel Horse,

I give and bequeath to my sister son Joseph William Perry fifty dollars in cash

I give and bequeath to Mary Ann Williams Perry one bed and furniture

I give and bequeath to Harriet Eliza Perry one bed and furniture

The Balance of my Estate in money and what will be sold by my Executor after deducting all necessary funeral expenses &c. I give and bequeath to my sister Perry two sons and two Daughters above named to share and share alike

In testimony of this my last will and I execute these my hands and set my seal this 31st of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight, and also do hereby appoint and ordain Francis W. Edwards Executor to this my last will & testament
