Item I desire that my lands be equally divided between my children William A Campbell, Thomas A Campbell and Elizabeth L Campbell as soon as they become of age. Item I desire that David Oliver and Malcolm Oliver have all the balance of my property that they keep whatever they want after and sell the balance and put it to the use of paying my just debts. Item It is my wish and desire that David Oliver and Malcolm Oliver take my children and keep them until they become of lawful age. That is David Oliver take William A Campbell and Elizabeth L Campbell and Malcolm Oliver take Thomas A Campbell and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my trusty friends David Oliver and Malcolm Oliver my lawful Executors to all intents and purposes to execute this my last will and Testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same and every part & clause thereof hereby reciting & declaring utterly void all other wills, testaments, by me made in this place whereof I the said Mary M Campbell do subscribe & say this day & year the 28th of Oct 1862.
