First That my executor hereinafter named shall provide for my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my relations, friends and pay all funeral expenses together with my just debts, thousands and to whomsoever owing out of the money that may first come into his hands as a part or parcel of my estate. Item it is my wish and desire that my land be rented out and the proceeds be put to the use of raising my children.

Item I desire that my land be equally divided between my children William A Campbell, Thomas A Campbell and Elizabeth C Campbell as soon as they become of age. Item I desire that David Oliver and Malcom Oliver have all the balance of my property that they keep what ever they want off and sell the balance and put it to the use of paying my just debts.

Item It is my wish and desire that David Oliver and Malcom Oliver take my children and keep them until they become of lawful age. That is David Oliver take William A Campbell and Elizabeth C Campbell and Malcom Oliver take Thomas A Campbell and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my trusty friends David Oliver and Malcom Oliver my lawful Executors to all intents and purposes to execute this my last will and Testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same and every part & clause thereof hereby revoking & declaring utterly void all other wills and Testaments by me made in witness whereof I the said Mary M Campbell do hereby set my hand and seal this 24th day of Novr 1862.
