

Norman McKinnon^s Will

I Norman McKinnon of the County of Moore
and State of North Carolina being of sound
mind and memory but Considering the uncertainty
of my earthly existence do make and declare
this my last will and Testament in manner
and form following that is to say First
that my executor (hereafter named) Shall
provide for my body a decent burial suitable
to the wishes of my relations and friends and
pay all funeral expenses together with
my just debts howsoever and to whomsoever
owing out of the monies that may first come
into his hands as a part or parcel of my estate
Item I give and bequeath unto my Neffew John
A. McKinnon Angus McKinnon dec'd son
One Negroe boy named Peter fifteen years
old last April and a Negroe woman
named Sally forty eight years old
last December and his daughter Lucy also
my blacksmith shop and Tools and a still
with fixtures and all Tools of every dis-
cription that now belong to me to be at
his disposal forever after my decease
Item I give and bequeath to my Niece Jennet Mc-
Kinnon Single woman (daughter of Angus
McKinnon dec'd) One Negroe woman named
Nancy thirty years of age and her child
a boy named Noah and one Chest.
Item I give and bequeath to my Niece Catharine
McKinnon Single woman daughter of
Angus McKinnon dec'd One Negroe woman
named Betsy thirty two years of age and
my bed and bed Stud and all the
Clothing belonging to any bed whatever
and one Chest
I give and bequeath to my brother Neff.
McKinnon now living in Montgomery
County and his Children apart

a part of a Negro Woman named Wmey
now living with him which I give and bequeath
as follows. I give her to him during his
natural life if he well see proper to keep
her if not let her be sold to make the following
deviseing which is as follows and will
ensure after his death. I give One fifth
of her unto her increase to Brother Daniel
McKinnon (dec'd) children now living in
Tennessee to be equally divided among
them and do one fifth of her and her increase
to Christian Clark Daniel McKinnon wife
daughter of Brother Angus McKinnon
dec'd and also One fifth of her and her
increase Anna Kennedy wife of Mr.
Kennedy daughter of Angus McKinnon
dec'd. Also I give to Mary Kennedy
wife of Duncan Kennedy daughter of
Angus McKinnon dec'd One fifth and her
increase. And to the children of brother
Asa^r McKinnon above mentioned one
fifth part his part of her and her increase
to be equally divided among his chil-
dren after his death except his son Mr.
McKinnon who will receive a sum of
dollars less than the others of said Asa^r
McKinnon children the above named
Mary and her increase I give and
bequeath to the above named heirs at
or before the death of the Mr. McKinnon
as he sees proper to do with the children
she has now with him or will have
hereafter
Item I also give and bequeath all the rest
of my money and other property whatsoever
to be equally divided between
the said John A. McKinnon Jennet
McKinnon and Catharine M^r

- innow. now living with me which it is my will and desire that after settling out the devises and legacies above mentioned, after paying of debts legacies and expences. that such sump-
tus. Shall be equally divided between the said John A. McKinnon and James M. McKinnon and Catharine M. McKinnon in equal proportion than and Share and Share alike to them and their administrators executors and their assigns for ever. Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my Trusty friend John A. McKinnon and Duncan M. Kennedy my lawful executors to all intents and purposes to execute this my last Will and Testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same and every part and clause thereof hereby revoking and declaring all that I did all other wills and Testaments by me heretofore made in writing whereof I the said Norman M. McKinnon do hereunto set my hands and seal this the 8th September 1857

North Carolina Court of Pleas and Quarter Sessions
Clay County 3 April Term 1858

The following paper writing was brought into Court by John G. Bickham thereby appointed Executor & offered for probate in common form as the last Will and Testament of Norman M. McKinnon and thereupon the Court ordered J. G. Bickham & Isaac Deaton Subscribing witness thereto to be duly sworn, who affirmed the

due execution of said paper writing & every part thereof to be and contain the last will & Testament of said Norman M. McKinnon, and it was admitted to probate in common form, by the Court and ordered to be recorded & filed among the records of the Court. Thereupon J. G. Bickham, one of the executors appointed by said will in open court declaimed his right to qualify as executor thereto and John A. McKinnon the other executor thereby appointed was duly qualified as executor of said will in open Court.
