

Peter Sinclair Will

August 31st 1842

State of North Carolina Moore County

I Peter Sinclair being of sound Mind and disposing Memory do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament which I give unto my beloved Wife two of my Horses her choice, all my Stock of Hags and Cattle Household and furniture of every description And all my Negroes or Slaves which I may have at my death and also my plantation on which I live on Crawley Creek to have during her lifetime or Widowhood and at her death my Negroes and all my property I Will to be sold by my Executors and to equally divided between my five Children and give to Mary Hadaworth during her lifetime my plantation on the governing back during her lifetime and at her death it is to go to her children then living I give to my daughter Jane Bell Sinclair four hundred Dollars and two hundred Cakes, and if there is not enough of personal property at my Wife's death to raise that sum for her my Executors is to raise that sum for her out of the sales of my Negroes, Over and above an Equal share with my other four Children I give to my Son Duncan M. Sinclair the plantation on which I live after the death of my Wife and he is to have the privilege of Timber during his Mother's lifetime at my death if my Wife deems it necessary she may have any of my Stock or cash sold by my Executors and have the money placed at Interest which is to be divided as aforesaid if she does not wish during her lifetime I constitute Duncan M. Sinclair & R. B. Hunt - is or Executors to this my last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I set my hand and seal at this
