and State of North Carolina being weak of body but of
sound mind and judgment and knowing that I am appointed for
all men once to die do hereby make and ordain this to be my
last will and Testament principally and first I recommend
my soul into the hands of Almighty God and my body to be
interred in a Christian and decent manner and form following
viz I give and bequeath unto my dearly beloved wife Sarah
Kellen all my real and personal Estate to her heirs and assigns
for ever after paying all my just debts and funeral Charges and
I do hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife Sarah Kellen
and John Sellers ^{her} Executors this my last will and
Testament Revoking and annulling all other former
wills and bequests heretofore by me made In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
fifth day of August 1802

and State of North Carolina being in a last state of health in body
but of sound mind and memory do make this my last will and
Testament by which I dispose of my worldly goods in the following
manner and form (viz) First I give and bequeath to my Daughter
Elizabeth Thompson in the State of Virginia a Negro Woman named
Frank and her heirs Item I give and bequeath to my son Henry
Street a Negro Girl called Rachel and a Negro Boy called William
a bed & furniture Item 3rd I give and bequeath to my Daughter
Ann Murly and her heirs & a Negro Woman called Rose and
two Children called Elvey, Amy Item 4th I give and bequeath
to my Daughter Susannah Graham a Negro Woman called
Thy and another called Sarah & and a Negro Boy named
John to descend to her heirs Item 5th I give and bequeath to
my two sons George and Richard Street jointly two Negro
Boys called Ebenezer & but the former of them is now in
their possession Item 6th I give to my Daughter Sarah Cile
a Negro Woman called Silby and her Child Son
as and another Girl called Phoebe also a young boy now
new in my possession Item 7th I give to my Daughter Frances
Street a Negro Woman called Hannah and her Child
Frank Item 8th I give & bequeath to my Daughter Rebecca
Street a Negro Girl called Patience & a Negro Boy called
Edmond Lastly I give and bequeath to my beloved
wife Elizabeth Street during natural life all my the
treasure of my Estate consisting of nine Negroes viz, Charles
Nan Dick Lisdah, Xquire, Rachel Lemmy Phil & plus some
together with all my household Furniture also all my Stocks
of every kind Consisting of horses Cattle hogs and Sheep a
Wagon or Grass also all my plantation Utensils and after
death to descend to my two sons George & Richard
Street & to my two Daughters Frances and Rebecca
Street I also will and desire the three hundred acres

of Land lying in Moore County to be sold to the highest bidder after due notice being previous given and two years credit given to the purchaser the sum arising therefrom to be equally divided among all my Children as above mentioned I further nominate and appoint my beloved wife Elizabeth Street Executrix & my two sons George & Richard Street Executors of this my last will and testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twelfth day of January 1804

Isabella Manes five Shillings I give and bequeath to my daughter Barbara Parke five Shillings I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Bruce five Shillings I give and bequeath to my daughter Sally Ruston five Shillings I give and bequeath to my son George Carringer five Shillings I give and bequeath to my son John Carringer five Shillings I give and bequeath to my son Peter Carringer five Shillings I give and bequeath to my son Daniel Carringer five Shillings I give and bequeath to my son David Carringer five Shillings has my will and pleasure is that which one of my Children in that death take the best care of my estate shall have all the rest of my property after paying my debts and I make and ordain my worthy friend William Wilson son Executor to this my last will and testament is to keep and send the said George Carringer hath hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year first above written signed sealed and declared by the said George Carringer in presence of us who was present at the signing and sealing thereof
