### The last will and Testament of Daniel Peterson Esq.

In the name of God Amen. I Daniel Peterson of the State of North-  
 Carolina Moore County Planter. being very sick and weak of but in  
 perfect mind and memory thanks be to God for its Calling unto mind the  
 Mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once  
 to die: do make and ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say  
 principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul into the hand of  
 Almighty God that gave it. and body I give to the Earth to be buried  
 in decent Christian Burial at the Discretion of my Executors nothing  
 doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again  
 by the mighty Power of God - and as touching such worldly Estate  
 wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me within this life I give  
 divide and dispose of the same in the following manner I promise  
 First I give and bequeath to my dear beloved wife all my goods  
 and Chattels Lands and Tenements Except such as is already named to any  
 of my Children in this will; and afterwards to be provided as follows  
 Item to my dear beloved son in Law Arch: Johnston and his wife  
 Sarah I give the third part of the land and Hags except a Cow a piece to his two  
 Daughters Mary & Catherine - Item to my dear beloved Daughter  
 Mary and my son in Law David Leach. I give a Negro black Homed  
 Slay and the third part of the cattle and Hags after all debts is paid and two  
 pieces of Land lying near the Graham Road containing 30 Acres in each  
 Item to my dear beloved Daughter Isabel and Duncan Campbell my  
 son in Law I give my Breeding place and 30 Acres lying between  
 him
