1st I give and bequeath to my dear sister Christiana McLeod all my wearing and bed clothing also also one bed board and dining table & one chest with all its contents -
2nd I give and bequeath to my dear sister Lewis Ann McLeod and my dear Brother Winnetta black my Negro man named Reuben to be equally divided between them first should there be any expense it must be paid out of his price before it be divided -
And I hereby make and ordain my worthy friend John McLeod Executor of this my last will and Testament in witness whereof I the said Sarah McLeod have to this my last will and Testament - set my hand and seal the day and year above written
