In the Name of God Amens. I John M^r Nalle of the County of Moore being in perfect Mind and Memory do make this my last Will and Testament. First Give and devise to my beloved wife Ann M^r Nalle the Plantation wherein I now live with Stock of Horses, Dogs, Cattle, and such Household and Kitchen furniture and farming utensils. Tales give and Devise to said Son Five Horses, Wiz, Gray, Joe, Brown, Africa and the boy, to have the said property during his natural life - After her death the property to be so divided so that all my children may have share and share alike and my widow and certain my son Lumbkin shall be Executor of my last will and testament - In witness Whereof I the said John M^r Nalle have to this my last Will and Testament set my hand and seal the 25th Fifty 1816.

Second Statute I published and declare John M^r Nalle Esq^r

Donald M^r Dugald's Will

In the Name of God Amun I Donald M^r Dugald of the County of Moore and State of North Carolina being sickly but in perfect Mind and Memory thanketh to the Almighty for his goodness continually minding the mortallity of the body and that it is appointed for all men once to die make unto ordain this to be my last Will and Testament first Command my soul to the almighty who gave it and my body to my friends to be buried in a decent and Christian like manner nothing doubting but I shall arise in the same at the Resurrection -

Give my true and beloved wife Mary Agnew and my selfe the plantation wherein I now live together with my Stock of Horses, Cattle, Dogs, Sheep, Turnings etc etc

Blessed Household furniture and every other article unto me belonging, this I ordain as my last Will and Testament and it is my will that my friends be buried there with, this 15th January 1814

Thomas Coles Will

On the 23rd day one thousand eight hundred and sixteen - I Thomas Coles of the County of Moore and State of North Carolina do make and order this my last Will and Testament - And first give and bequeath Will to my son in law one Dollar & to my son Andrew one Dollar to my son John of alive Twenty Dollars and to my son James Twenty Dollars to my son William Fifty Acres of Land lying on the East side of the Beaver Branch River by the Name of the Bateman tract - After the above mentioned sum of money are raised out of my Estate the remainder of my lands stocks and Household furniture and debts that is to say all my real and personal Estate I leave to my wife During her widowhood by her to be freely used and enjoyed - and after her widowhood or death if she deceased Mary all my personal property shall be equally divided among all her children Also to the lands not mentioned before that tract wherein I now live I leave to my son George and that tract I bought of Coler Johnston to my son Thomas - And an other tract of fifty acres joining that tract I will leave to my son Richard - and I appoint my wife and my son William to be my Executors - and I hereby disannul all other former Wills, Testaments or bequests whatsoever Relating and concerning this and no other to be my last Will and Testament in witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal day and year above written Test
