I James B. Cheek of the County of More and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory but Considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and declare this my last will and testament in manner and form following this is to say

Item that my executor (hereinafter named) shall provide for my body a decent burial suit able to the wishes of my relations and friends and pay all final expenses together with my just debts however and to whomsoever owing out of the money that may first come into his hands by a just or part of my estate

Item I give and bequeath to my brother Jacob Cheek the whole of my real and personal estate including all my lands negroes debts due, monies and account,

Item I give and devise to my said brother Jacob Cheek all the right title

intest claim or claims which I now have or here after may have in and to all or any part or share of the estate of my father Jacob Cheek, either real or personal goods chattels land, tenements rights or credits or recreations either in law or equity or any thing part or parcel that may her after or heretofore descended by virtue of the will and testament of my father Jacob Cheek

Item My will and desire is that my said brother Jacob shall have and own all the increased and profits arising from my estate from this time forward

Item My will and desire is that my executor herein after named may at the request of my said brother Jacob sell either for cash or for approved credit any or all of my estate of will real and personal as any goods or chattels pertaining to my said Estate and the proceeds thereof I give the whole and every part thereof to my said brother Jacob Cheek his heirs and assigns forever

And lastly I hereby constitute and appoint my said brother Jacob Cheek my lawful executor to all intents and purposes to execute this my last will and testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same and every part and clause thereof hereby reciting and declaring utterly void all other wills and testaments by me hitherto made In Writing whereof I the said James B. Cheek do hereunto set my hand and seal this 27th day June AD 1888
