Lord 1844 I make and publish this my last
will and Testament -

First - I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife
Elizabeth Williams - all my real and personal
estate of every kind during her life time after
paying all my just debts -

Second - I give unto my son Thomas one horse that
he received from me when twenty one years
of age, which is all that my estate will afford him

Thirdly - I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Stanley better one bed and furniture which
she has received when she left me -

Fourth - I give and bequeath unto my son William
Williams one horse which he received when
became of age being his third of my estate

Fifth - I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary
one bed and furniture which she received
when she left my being her share of my of my
estate

Sixth - I give and bequeath unto my son Joseph Williams
one horse which he received when he became
twenty one years of age and all of my
lands which is above given unto his mother
during her life time which he is to have
at her death -

Seventh - I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Sarah Williams all and every part and
parcel of my personal estate at her
mother's death

Eighth - Lastly I appoint Bailey Williamson Esqr.
my worthy friend as Executor to this my last
will and Testament -
