North Carolina, in the name of god amon I Malcolm McWilliams of the County before being weak in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory thank be god for it I do make and publish this my last will and Testament in the manner and form following that is to say first I give and bequeath unto my three Daughters two hundred and fifty acres of land Mary Effey and Henry as long as they keep together and stay in the place and after they all leave it I give and bequeath the above two hundred and fifty acres to my son Neil and all the farming necessary And the house and one more to till the plantation of the same as the rest will loose here as well as Effey by Effey breaks off from the family She may take the same and two hundred each south to its own creature I give and bequeath unto the above Henry all the stock that belongs to the plantation cattle hogs and sheep except one Sheep to Nathaniel Bridges I give and bequeath to Mary Effey and Henry under tith all the house hold furniture and the gear I have by appoint John Williams and John Patterson Executors the above entituled was before Sealed or delivered In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the 23 day of April in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and twenty two

In the name of God amon I Williams Wright Senior of the County of Moore State of North Carolina Being of sound and perfect mind and memory before God do this Twenty First day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and four and twenty years and publish this my Last will and Testament in manner following that is to say first I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son Joseph Wright and his wife Anna Wright ten shillings each Secondly I gave and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Sophia Gwyn Mary Williams Senior probate Elizabeth alias Lydia Shum borgher truly Wards the sum of Ten shillings Each & no more the day I Give and bequeath unto my son Shadwell Wright one hundred acres of land called the old house including the plantation where I now live and also all my Goody and chattels Rites and credits of every kind that shall remain after my debts are paid and the above named legacies are paid at my death and my wife Elizabeth death But the whole to remain in the hands and possessions of me and my beloved wife Elizabeth for & during our natural lives Except such part as may be necessary applied to the support pay monthly of the gifts which are contracted at our death and thereby make and ordain my worthy Son William and Shadwell Wright Executors of this my last will and Testament in witness whereof I the said William Wright Senior have to this my last will and Testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written Sealed published and declared by the said William Wright the testator of his last will and Testament in the presence of us
