Millar of the County of Moore being weak in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be God for it I do make and publish this my last will and Testament in the manner and form following that is to say first I Give and bequeath unto my three Daughters two hundred and fifty acres of land Mary Effy and Eliza as long as they live to Eliza and stay in the place and after they all have I Give and bequeath the above two hundred and fifty acres to my son Will. and all the farming utensils And the house and one more to till the plantation if the male die the wife will live here as well as Effy but if Effy breaks off from the family she may take the house and two servants each servant to its own breed I Give and bequeath unto the above Mary all the stock that belong to the plantation cattle hogs and sheep except one Kipper to Nathaniel Bridges I Give and bequeath to Mary Effy and Eliza and Will all the house hold furniture and the gear I here by appoint John McMillan and John Patterson Executors The above written was before sealed or delivered In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the 23 day of April in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and twenty two.

William Wright's Will

In the name of God amen I William Wright Son of the County of Moore State of North Carolina being of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed God do this Twenty First day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty two make and publish this my last will and Testament in the manner following that is to say first I Give and bequeath unto my beloved son Joseph Wright which I will William Wright ten Shillings Each Secondly I Give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Eliza Wright Mary Williams Nancy prebent Elizabeth Allen Liza Shuman larger body words the sum of Ten Shillings Each & no more Thirdly I Give and bequeath unto my son Sharod Wright one hundred acres of land called the old hand including the plantation where I now live and also all my Goods and Chattels Bats and Credit of every kind that shall remain after my debts are paid and the above named Legacies are paid at my death and my wife Elizabeth death But the whole to remain in the hands and possession of me and my beloved wife Elizabeth for & during our natural lives Except such part as may be necessarily applied to the payment of my debts of the debts which are contracted at our death and I hereby make and Ordain My Worthy Sons Watson and Sharod Wright Executors of this my last Will and Testament in witness whereof I the said William Wright Son have to this my last will and Testament set my hand and Seal the day and year above written and sealed published and declared by the said William Wright the testator as his last will and Testament in the presence of us
