Item: Then I give and bequeath to my son Limiterd Williams one negro boy Seser and onehorse or fortey five dollars and three cows and calves one bed and furniture , six plates two basons one dish and one saddle. then I leave laneaster, and Vine and modey to be sold by my executors

pay all my lawfull debts.

Item : I lend to my beloved wife Charity Williams all the rest of my negroes , land and property that is not willed away her life time or widow hand if she should marrie and the estate likely to be wasted my executors is to give her whatethey think proper to live upon and at her death all my land that I have willed away to be sold and themoney arising from eaid sale ofland to be divided among my four boys William williams, Lawrence Williams, Benjamin Williams, and Lunford Williams all the rest of my property likewise to be sold and the money arising from said sale to be divided among all my children ar their heirs and I hereby make and or ain my worthy friends Gorge Williams, Henry Williams and Jesse Hammond executors of this my last will and testaments in witness whereof I the said Benjamin Williams have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written , signed, sealed published and delivered by the said Benjamin Williams testactr as his last will and testament in he presence of us who was present at thetime of signing and scaling thereof.
