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I Ann L Harrison of Nash County N
Carolina having by virtue of a marriage
contract with my husband James Harrison
which was concluded the 24th of July 1854
power to dispose of by will or otherwise my
lands and certain of my personal prop-
erty and being of sound and mind
and disposing memory do make this
my last will and testament to wit,
I thus I give and bequeath to my husband
James Harrison one bed and furniture
his choice then I give and bequeath to
my niece Carry Burr my Silver Table Spoons
and Silver Tea Spoons then I give and
bequeath to my grand niece Sallie E
Thorp one bed and furniture then I
give and bequeath and devise to my niece
Sarah E Burr and her heirs my Stony
Hill plantation by which I mean to in-
clude also my lands adjoining the old Stony
Hill tract all my interest in the Clarifet
tract of land adjoining the lands of
Littell Arrington the James Arrington
tract the land that John Davis pur-
chased of White and others with all the
rights and appurtenances thereto be-
longing to the said two tracts of land
I also give and bequeath to the said
Sarah E Burr all my personal property
at the said Stony Hill plantation con-
sisting of House hold and kitchen furni-
ture ~~my~~ crockery ware trunks and
contents bed & furniture except the two
shrubbery given. Carriage & harness and
new things and such other personal
as I may own at my death except
such money and evidence of debt as I
may dispose of before or at my death
by personal delivery to other persons or
request to be delivered to them by friends

near me at my death And I hereby request
and direct the proper representatives of my
trustee William James Burr deacon or others
whose duty it may be to make the proper
conveyances and do such other acts as may
be necessary to enforce and carry out the
above intentions and disposals after my death
I hereby constitute and appoint my niece
Sarah E Burr my lawful executor to ex-
ecute this my last will and testament wit-
ness my hand and seal A. D. 1870
