Imprimis:— I lend to my wife Elizabeth Bell theland and plantation whereon I now dwell centaining by estimation two hundred and fifty æres be it more or less also my negre fellow Peter for and during her life or widewhood, and at her death or day of marriage Ingive the above mentioned land and plantation to myfwe sons Bengmin Bell and William Bell; also the above mentioned negfee Peter to my son Arthur Bell to them their heirs and assigns forever.

Item:— I give to my sons James Bell, Thomas Bell, and Green Bell, Two hundred acres of land that was conveyed some by Jeseph Pasmore, be the same more or less; also all my right to an entry of land that was entered by Elias Bell to them their heirs and assigns forever.

Item:- I give to my son :Green Bell, two cows and calves also two ewes and lambs one ted and furniture to him his heirs and assigns forever.

Item:- I give to my son Green Bell one iron pot to him his heirs and assigns.

Item:- I give to my sen Thamas Bell two Ewe and lambs to him his heirs and assigns farear.

Item:- I give to my two daughters Sarah Beek and Elvilah Statter ten shilling to each of them and no more.

And all the rest and residue of my estate of what kind or quality it may be of, I lend to my wife Elizabeth Bell for and during her life or widewheed, and at her death or day of marriage, I give and bequeath the same to my three children to wit, Benjamin Bell, William Bell, and Arthur Bell to them their heirs and assigns forever.

I do constitute and appoint my wife Elizabeth Bell executive and my son Green Pell Executor to this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 13th lay of September, one Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Eight.
