Item: I also lend to my leving wife Charity during life or widowhood one gray mare and one greay filley four cows and thee calves four feather beds and furniture three sows andpiggs four shoats all my old corn and all my wheat and all my standing crop of all kinds accept 24 barrels of corn reserved for the fating of a parcel of hogs, also I lend to my wife charity my bason fat two pots one duch oven, one frying pan three basons two dishes six plates all species all my knives and forks my chairs one table, one chest all my flax and cotton wheels and cards one meal sifter, one bread tray one meal barrell one basket, one hacket two accessone grubing hoe two prew hoes, and frames and one small churn one mans saddle one hunting saddle and bridle one tub one pail two piggons four sides of leather all my goese and half

all my games and half the other follow one hive and bees two broad hoes one guardin hoe.

Item: I will and desire that my negro pat And my negro Boy Lewis be hired for the term of Twelve years.

Item: I give and bequeath to my son Benjamin after the term of twelve years one negro boy named Lewis to him his heirs and assigns for ever.

Item: I give and bequeath after the term of twelve years to my daughter "hoda one negro wowns named pat to her andher heirs and assigns forever..

Item: I willand desire that all the money arising from the hire of said negros for the term of twelve years be equally divided between my four daughters "hoda Morning, Rachel and Delilah them their heirs am assigns forever,

Item: I give and bequeath to my four daughters Ahoda , Morning, Rachel, and Delilah after my wifes death all the estate I have left to her during life excepting the negroes to be equally divided between my four daughters Rhoda, Morning, Rachel and Deliah then their heirs and assigns forever.

Item: I will and desire that all the rest of my estate notalready mentioned in this will be equally divided between my four daughters and my two youngest sens to wit Edwin, Benjamin, Rhods, Morning, machel and Delilah them their heirs and assigns for ever.

Item: I do hereby constitute and appeint my loving wife charity and my Pro.
