Item:- I give and bequeath to my daughter Betty one negro boy named Moses likewise one feather bed and furniture and all the remainder of my estate to be equally divided between my two daughters Betty Wall and Sarah Wall but if in case my two daughters both die without lawful heirs my desire is that all my estate should fall unto Nathan Powell son of Nathaniel Powell, deceased but if one of my children should die then the deseast ones part to fall to the other child and lastly I anominate and appoint John Powell and James Cain to execute this my last will and testament.
