My will and desire is that my wife and my children that remain single at my decease may have the use of the plantation during the time they live single and the rest of my estate to be equally divided between my daughters Julien Turner and my daughter Nanny Turner and my daughter Elizabeth Turner and my son James Turner and my two grandsons Lazarus Turner and John Valentine after my decease.

Lastly I nominate and appoint my wife Ann Turner and my son James Turner to execute this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal, this the thirtieth day of April in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and eighty eight.
