Item: I give mate my son William Harrison five hundred gores of land that I Bought of William and Jethro Philips a line to be run east and west so as to leave that number of acres north of my manner. Plantation one negro man named Dick and one Brandey still to him and hisheirs forever.

Item: I give unto my son Jethro Hafrison the land and plantation whereon I Now live as far as the south Pronge of the spring branch one negro woman named Grace one Brandey still that is set up on thelands one horse bridle and saddle two cows, calves, three ewes and lambs two sowsand pigs one feather ted and furniture and the buffet the house to him and his heirs forever.

Item: I give unto to my son Dempsey Harrison the lands that I bought of Jets Sanders and all the remainder of mylami not as yet given a line to be the the aforesaid spring branch to my back line andone negro man named

Item: I give unto my daughter mancey Horn one negro boy that she has in her possession named Ben and one negro woman named Hannah to her and her heirs forever.

Itam: I give unto my daughter Polley Grice one negro boy that she has inher possession named Hardey and one negro woman named Jinney to her and her heirs forevery

Iten: I give unto my daughter Temperance Holden one negro girl that she had in possession named Silvea and one negro boy named Washington to ber and herrheirs forever.

Item: I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Harrison one negro woman named Seleth and one negro boy named Jacob two cows and calves these ewes and lambs one bed and furniture to her and her heirs forever.

Item: I give unto my daughter Milbress Harrisch one negro woman named Jone, and one negro man named Jack one bed and furniture, two cows and calves three ews and lambs to her and her heirs forever.

Item: I give unto my two grandsons James and Jethre Ricks sons of my daughter Morning Ricks AAL. Fiftey Dollars each to be all that I now give them or hereafter to themand their heirs forever.

I likwise give unto my two daughters Blizabeth and Milbray Harrison, one negro girl named Sarah to be equally divided between them and their heirs forever.

My will and desire is that my old negro woman Phillis be at liberty to choose which of my children she will desire with and that if it is thought that she is not able to work sufficient to maintain her self that the one she chooses to live with be allowed a sum of money out of my estate for the support of said negro during her life time.

My will and desire further is that after my just debts and legacies be paid that the remainder of my property be equally divided amongst allmy children then living.

My will further is that Henry Atkins, William Horn and William Moore one two of them, be appointed to attend the sale of my property and bid of of my property as the may think proper for my two daughters that is under age, Slizabeth and Milbery Harrison and not to be liable to any loss for any stock or any other article that they may bid of for said daughters and I do hereby constitute, ordain and appoint my son William Harrison, Charles Coleman and William White my hole and sole executors of thismy last will and testament ratifying this and no other to be my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal, the day and year

first above written.
