sheep two sows and pigs and one shorse creature her choice one hunting saddle and bridle one chest six chairs one spinning wheall and one pair of cards one flax wheal two iron pots and two iron pot racks and all the rest of my kitchen furniture one plow frame and gear one cart and wheels and for her tohave one years allowance of provisions laid off in themanner prescribed bylaw, orde-weeding hee two axes one grubbing hee during her natural life.

Item: My desire is that the remainder part of my estate both in doors and out doors be sold equally divided between my five children to wit Febraha Baker, Willie Bone, Nelson Bone, Nancy Bick, and Mary Polen and I do also constitute and appoint my son helsonBone executor of this my last will and testament inwitness whereof I have set my hand and seal this the 8th day of January 1824.
