At the deathof my wife I give and bequeath tony daughter Elizabeth Winstead one negro girl by the name of Marriett tegether with her increase from this day to her and her heirs forever, At the death of my wife I is andbeguenthtony daughter Maney Deans the following negroes to wit Cook Jinny andher son Datid nagre weman Easter and her son Robert to, ther with their increase from this day to her and her heirs forever.

I was giveher one horse named Starling and two beds and furniture. At the death of mywife its my desire that the house hold and kitcen furniture be sold, with the exception of two bads andfurniture, and the proceeds arising therefrom I give to my daughter Mary Atginson. I give and bequeath tomy son David M. Deans the following negroes to wit: one negre an by the name of Prants one negro girl by the name of Tammey and onenegro girl by thename of Barah, together with their increase from this day to him and to his heirs forever. I give and bequeathto my son Marcum H. Deans onenegro man by the name of Elias and onenegro woman by the name of Caroline, together with her increase from this day to him and his heirs forever.

I give and bequeath to my son John B. Denns one negro man by the name of Sampson and one negro man by the name of Berry tohim and hisheirs forover. I give and bequeathto my daughter Elizabeth Winstead one negro man by the name of Branch and one negro woman by the name of Mourning and her child, together with their increase from this day to her andher heirs forever. I give and bequestate my sons David M. Beane and Marcum H. Deans the balance of myland lying above the home plantation to be equally divided, to them andteir heirs forever.

It is then my further will anddesire that mythree sone David M., Marcum H. and John E. Deans pay the balance of myjust debts.
