Item: I give and bequeath to my loving son William Pauland all the remainder part of my estate both real and personal to him and his heirs forever, my desire is also that he may have the full and whole possession of it although he be not at age.

I do hereby constitute make and ordain my son in law Jonas Williams my whole and sole executor of this my last will and testament revoking and disallowing all other as witness my hand and seal, the day and year first written.

Whereas, I John Turlington of Nash County, in the State of North Carolina being weak in body yet of a sound and disposing mind and memory do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following to wit.

Item. I lend to my loving wife Elizabeth the plantation whereon I now live with all the land belonging thereto during her natural life or widowhood and then to revert to my daughter Mary Turlington to be held and enjoyed by her and her heirs forever.

Item: I also give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Turlington one cow and calf to be held by and enjoyed by her and her heirs forever.

Item: I also lend to my wife Elizabeth all the rest and residue of my estate during her natural life or widowhood. Then the said residue and remainder of my estate I will and desire may be equally divided between my two sons namely Timothy and Thomas to be held and enjoyed by them and their heirs forever.

Item: I do constitute and appoint my friend Jacob Ricks my whole and sole executor to this my last will and testament ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal, this 22 day of September one thousand seven hundred and eighty three.
