Item: I also lend to my wife Elizabeth all the rest and residue of my estate during her natural life or widewhood. Then the said residue and remainder of my estate I will and desire may be equally divided between my two sons namely Timethy and Thomas to be held and enjoyed by them and their heirs forever.

Item: I do constitute and appeint my friend Jacob Ricks my whole and sole executors to this my last will and testament ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will andtestament inwitness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal, this 22 day of September one thousand seven hundred and eighty three.
