Item: My will and desire also is that all the property which I have not given away of all kinds whatseever be sold at publick sale and after my just debts are paid out of themoney rising from such sale a together with the meney now due me that if there should be remaining in the hands of my executors the sum of five hundred dollars of said money that my sisters hartha, "lizabeth and "ancy Nicholson should have one Hundred Dollars each, to them and their heirs forever.

Item: I give and bequeath to my son Isaac Watkins all my land lying on the south side of Kirbys creek in cluding the falls of Tar river together with onehalf of my part of the mill also half of my still also one negro man named Jim and one boy named Tom and one horse to him his heirs and assigns forever.

Rem: My will and desire is that the Balance of my negroes which are not impresent given ar lest be equally divided between my four youngast children
