I Joseph Barp of Mash County and State of North Carolina being weak in body but sound in mind and memory thanks be to God but calling into mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for man once to die do make and ordain this my last will and testament that is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul unto the hands of God and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent christen like manner at the discretion of my execution and as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give and bequeath in the manner and form following than I give and bequeath to my daughter Holley Murry one heifer.

Item: I give and bequeath to my daughter Waney Barp one bed and furniture and one heifer.

Item: I give and bequeath to my son Richard Barp one third part of my land one horse and one saddle and one heifer.

Item: I give and bequeath to my son William Barp one third part of my land one heifer.

Item: I give and bequeath to my son Joseph Barp one third part of my land and one heifer and one colt.

Item: then I give and bequeath to my daughter Lize Barp one bed and furniture and one heifer.

Item: then I give and bequeath to my daughter Polley Barp one bed and furniture and one heifer.

Item: then I give and bequeath to my daughter Tempey Barp one bed and furniture and one heifer.

Item: then I lend to my beloved wife Silvey Barp her life time as much

of the land where we now live as she can tend or have it tended with out any interruption of the boys also all the rest of my property that I have willed away but she is to pay all my lawfull debts out of my stock and at my wifes death then I give all the property to my five daughters Holley Murry, Waney Barp, Lize Barp, Polley Barp and Tempey Barp, or their heirs forever.

And I thereby make and ordain my worthy friend Jesse Hammond executor of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I the said Joseph Barp have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written. Signed, sealed and published and delivered by the said Joseph Barp the testator as his last will and testament in the presence of us who was present at the time of signing and sealing thereof.
