Item: I lend to my loving wife, Elizabeth Selah all and singular the residude of my estate during her natural life except one negro girl named thancy and her to be sold the money arising from said sale to go to my wife for the use of raising my children and at the death of my wife all the remains of my estate to be equally divided between my four yours children namely Richard Selah, Rodah Selah, Elizabeth Selah, and Morning Selah to be enjoyed by them and their heirs forever.

I de also constitute and appoint my loving wife Elizabeth Selah and my friend' Sam Westray executors to this my last will and testamentin witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this sixteenth day of August anno domni 1792.
