" 5th It is my will and desire that after the death of my beloved wife Mary A. W Vick all my real estate be sold to her in item three above of this Will be equally divided by me and bonds between my children mentioned in item (3) two

Item 6 It is my will and desire that the personal property bequeathed to my beloved wife Mary A. W Vick in item 3 above be sold at her death and the proceeds of sale be equally divided between my children mentioned in Item (3) five of this will.
