Item: I give and bequeath to my daughter Guliema Griffin all what I already possessed her with to her her heirs and assigns forever.

Item: I give and bequeath to my grand daughters Mary White and Milcent White one feather bed bolster and pair of sheets to them their heirs and assigns forever.

Item: After paying my just debts I give and bequeath all the rest and residue of my estate to my beloved wife Quilimus White to dispose of as she thinks fit.
