I Lett Whidden, Sen. of the County of Nash being sick and weak of body but of perfect mind and memory and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and testament (to-wit)

Inprimis: I give and bequeath to my loving wife Sarah Whidden during her life or widow hood all my household goods of every kind ,beds,pots,pans,pewter &c. and all my stock of horses ,cattle , hogs and sheep and plantation. Utensils for her use for and during her life or widowhood and at her death or marriage when either happens I give and bequeath all my estate as above mentioned to my three children to wit, Maxwell, Elizabeth, and James Whidden and that their be an equal division of it among them three as above mentioned and I do appoint my son William Whedden and my friend Marcom Cooper ,Executersto this my last will and testament revoking all others by me heretofore made.
