I, Richard Maning of the State of North Carolina Nash County being of sound mind and memory make ordain constitute and appoint this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say.  
Item. I lend unto my beloved mother Sarah Hatfield the use of the plantation where on I now live containing three hundred acres more or less . I also lend her the use of one negro man Jacob , one horse, four hundred wight of bacon five barrels of corn, two hoes and one axe and cow and calf during her life.

Item: I give <sup>unto</sup> my beloved son Samuel Manning two pounds money.

Item: I give unto my son Thomas Manning one bed and furniture.

Item: I gave unto my son Michal Maning one bedding and furniture.

Item: I gave unto my son James Maning the plantation that I lend unto my mother after her death to him and his heirs forever, also one bed and furniture one horse colt and saddle.

Item: I gave unto my daughter Phareby Peepe one bed and furniture and one chest which she has now in possession.

Item: I gave unto my daughter Nancy Maning one bed and furniture.

My will and desire is that after my just debts are paid that all my estate of everykind that has not been given away heretofore shall be sold and equally divided between Thomas Maning , Michael Maning, James Manning , Phereby Peepe and Nancy Maning to them and their heirs forever.
